Message From the Board of Trustees

BSNL (Brahmin Society North London)

Charity Incorporated Organisation (CIO)

Jai Shree Krishna,

As agreed at our last AGM, our Board of Trustees have initiated a project in consultation with The Charity Commission and Navinbhai Thaker, our past Auditor for many years (and his company which has expertise in matters to do with CIO) to convert BSNL's current Charity status from being an 'Unincorporated Charity' to a 'Charity Incorporated Organisation'. At present, as an 'Unincorporated Charity' we are unable to hold our property in the name of BSNL or enter into any contract in the name of BSNL.

Instead BSNL Property Title Deed has to be held in the name of four (4) trusted individual custodians. Similarly contracts such as our lease agreement with the children's nursery or any other contracts must be in the names of the signatory trustees which make them personally liable.

BSNL's current registered status as an 'Unincorporated Charity' is no longer appropriate for BSNL, since BSNL owns its property and engages in issuing contracts.

The more appropriate structure according to The Charity Commission is for BSNL to become a 'Charity Incorporated Organisation' which will enable BSNL to enter into contracts in the name of BSNL, hold our property in the name of BSNL, to reduce liabilities of individual trustees, members and to give us several other benefits.

We will keep you informed on the progress.
