**Samaiyo** at 8pm followed by **Garba** — This is a daily ritual whereby any family may request the honour of welcoming *Mataji* to our *Garba*. **Aarti** — At 9.30pm. Anyone is welcome to perform the **Aarti**, however please bring one **Aarti** Thali (with one divo only) per family and ensure you collect it at the end of the evening. There is no charge for this.

**Prasad** — You are welcome to bring **Prasad** but please ensure all sweets etc. are approved as suitable for vegetarians so that they are appropriate for offering to **Mataji** and make organisers aware of / label items containing nuts to avoid risk of allergic reaction.
